The Staff Recommended 10 year Capital Budget and Plan includes a total of \$1.546 billion (including carry forward funding) for the construction of projects in the Basement Flooding Protection Program (BFPP) over ten years. The estimated cost to construct projects identified by the EA studies in an expanded city-wide BFPP (including construction projects not presently within the existing 34 priority study areas) will require additional capital funding beyond the 10 year planning period.
