The Lobbyist Registrar may report to City Council in respect of an inquiry and may disclose in the report such matters as in the Registrar's opinion are necessary for the purposes of the report, s. 169 of the City of Toronto Act, 2006 (COTA). Section 3-7 of the Toronto Municipal Code provides that the Registrar reports to Council on investigations and inquiries.

It is standard practice to report to Council on a completed prosecution. This provides the necessary transparency and informs public office holders as well as the public.

The Lobbyist Registrar will not be withdrawing or amending this report.
