SUMMARY

The purpose of this report is to recommend Council Member appointments to the Scarborough Community Preservation Panel.

DECISION HISTORY

Council appointed Members in February 2013 for a term of office ending November 30, 2014 and until successors are appointed. It is now necessary to appoint Members for the new term of Council.
