# Parking Regulation Amendment – Brule Terrace

#### SUMMARY

This staff report is about a matter that Community Council has delegated authority from City Council to make a final decision.

The purpose of this report is to obtain approval to implement a maximum two-hour parking regulation on the northeast side of Brule Terrace, from Bloor Street West to Brule Gardens, to be in effect between 8:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m., Monday to Friday. The proposed regulation will help reduce the occurrence of long duration daytime parking on Brule Terrace.

## RECOMMENDATIONS

### Transportation Services recommends that Etobicoke York Community Council:

1. Authorize parking for a maximum period of two-hours from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., Monday to Friday on the northeast side of Brule Terrace between Bloor Street West and Brule Gardens.

#### **Financial Impact**

The estimated cost for amending the signs is \$600.00. These funds are included within the Transportation Services 2016 Operating Budget.

#### ISSUE BACKGROUND

The Ward Councillor forwarded a petition signed by the majority of homeowners on Brule Terrace requesting Transportation Services to implement a daytime maximum two hour parking restriction on the northeast side of Brule Terrace between Bloor Street West and Brule Gardens due to concerns with long term daytime parking of vehicles. A map of the area with the existing and proposed parking regulations is Attachment 1.

#### COMMENTS

Brule Terrace is a two-lane road classified in the City's Road Classification System as a "Local" roadway. Brule Terrace is located just south of Bloor Street West and to the west of South Kingsway. Brule Terrace does not have sidewalks on either side of the street.

Currently, parking is prohibited at all times on the southwest side of Brule Terrace. During our observations we did note vehicles parked on the northeast side, in the area in which is currently subject to the unsigned maximum three-hour parking by-law. Based on the request from the Councillor's office and staff's examination of this matter, it is recommended that a maximum two-hour parking restriction between 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., Monday to Friday be implemented on the northeast side of Brule Terrace between the Bloor Street West and Brule Gardens. This proposed restriction will help in reducing the number of vehicles parking for extended periods of time.
