Re: Request to Re-open Item EY13.30, headed "Traffic Calming/Speed Limit - Mould Avenue, between St. Clair Avenue West and Pritchard Avenue"

## **SUMMARY:**

At its meeting on April 5, 2016, Etobicoke York Community Council adopted, as amended, Item EY13.30, headed "Traffic Calming/Speed Limit - Mould Avenue, between St. Clair Avenue West and Pritchard Avenue," which authorized a poll to be undertaken to determine support for Traffic Calming on Mould Avenue. Subject to favourable results of the poll, traffic calming is to be installed, together with a reduction in the speed limit on Mould Avenue.

The speed limit reduction was not to have been linked to the results of the Traffic Calming Poll, and was to be implemented immediately.

## **RECOMMENDATIONS:**

That Etobicoke York Community Council:

- 1. Re-open Item EY13.30, headed "Traffic Calming/Speed Limit Mould Avenue, between St. Clair Avenue West and Pritchard Avenue", only as it pertains to Parts 2b and 2c of the decision.
- 2. Remove Sections b and c from Part 2 of the decision, and renumber them as stand-alone, so that the decision of EY13.30 now includes the following Parts 3 and 4:

**Etobicoke York Community Council:** 

- 3. Approved a reduction in the speed limit on Mould Avenue, between St. Clair Avenue West to Pritchard Avenue, from 40 km/h to 30 km/h.
- 4. Approved a reduction in the speed limit on Mould Avenue, from Pritchard Avenue to Corbett Avenue, from 50 km/h to 30 km/h.
