### **Review of Proposed Noise By-law**

#### **Committee Decision**

The Toronto Music Industry Advisory Council recommends that the Licensing and Standards Committee:

- 1. Request the General Manager, Municipal Licensing and Standards to work with the Toronto Music Industry Advisory Council and the General Manager, Economic Development and Culture to develop a communications strategy, on the new Noise By-law, when adopted, for music industry stakeholders that includes:
  - a. a summary of the new noise by-law;
  - b. information on how violations will be treated;
  - c. details on how enforcement will be carried out; and,
  - d. an explanation of the increased fines for violation of the by-law.
