We believe that developing an appropriate Noise Management Plan is crucial for our City and that the needs of residents and businesses can be accommodated. However we submit that the City's current proposals have serious flaws. The Toronto Noise Coalition (www.torontonoisecoalition.ca) has been formed to reconsider these issues and has recently put forward proposals for a more effective approach to a noise bylaw. The TNC recommends a 7 point plan for moving forward. The issues addressed include general protection against unwanted noise, and the issues of construction noise, amplified noise and leaf blowers.
