Thank you for your consideration in asking our Division's opinion on the traffic calming measures being considered for both Glenwood Crescent and Coleman Avenue.

I understand from your email that both streets satisfy the installation criteria for calming devices. I certainly understand that the residents want traffic slowed down in their neighborhoods, and this will lead to a safer community.

The only caveat I add is that these bumps are a hindrance to emergency vehicles. What slows vehicular traffic, also slows emergency vehicle traffic.

I recognize, however, that emergency vehicles are less frequent than other vehicles that use the street. Therefore, residents may feel the "trade-off" is certainly worth it.
