The Executive will make its final recommendations on May 16, 2017, which will be forwarded to City Council for consideration at its meeting on May 24, 25 and 26, 2017.

While the General Manager, Toronto Water and the Deputy City Manager and Chief Financial Officer do not recommend the implementation of a stormwater charge at this time, the recommendations are subject to the decision of Executive Committee and the decision of City Council. Consequently, the recommendations may be modified.

Further, Toronto City Council may adopt the Stormwater Charge Model outlined in the Report, or charges that differ from the model outlined in the Report, including charges that are higher or lower, or new charges that are not contemplated in the Report.

The charges, if adopted, will be implemented through a by-law that will amend the Municipal Code, if necessary.
