The purpose of this report is to recommend the appointment of Members of Council to the Toronto Realty Agency Board.

1. Striking Committee consider Members' preferences and recommend to City Council the appointment of two Council Members to the Toronto Realty Agency Board for a term starting when the public members of the Board are appointed and ending November 30, 2018 and until successors are appointed.

DECISION HISTORY

City Council at its meeting on May 24, 25 and 26, 2017 established the Toronto Realty Agency Board to oversee the new City agency created to manage the City's real estate portfolio, develop City buildings and lands for municipal purposes and deliver client focused real estate solutions to City Divisions, Agencies and Corporations.
