## Re: Traffic Study – Keele, Dundas West, Pacific, and Vine Corridor

Traffic concerns have continued to grow in the Junction neighbourhood, with a recent studies showing a dramatic increase in the volume of traffic on local roads in the area. With six development applications in the Junction community, three of which are in the Keele Street, Dundas Street West, Pacific Avenue, and Vine Street corridor, this issue will continue to grow.
