Subject: 1783-1785 Bayview Avenue East

We write in connection with the captioned property, acquired in support of the Eglinton Crosstown Light Rail Transit project (ECLRT) and to advise of the status of the disposition of these lands.

As set out in our letter dated 12 January 2018 and considered by the Heritage Preservation Board on April 19, 2018, the land is intended for disposition but not until the completion of the Leaside Transit station that is being constructed at the southeast corner of Bayview and Eglinton Avenues, a part of the ECLRT. The station is presently scheduled for completion September 2021, and therefore the disposition is not imminent.

We trust this helps to clarify the matter of the disposition.
