City of Toronto Act, 2006 Public Notice

Proposed Permanent Closure of a Portion of the North Side of Steeles Avenue West, between Islington Avenue and the Humber River

Toronto City Council will be considering recommendations to pass a by-law to permanently close a portion of the north side of Steeles Avenue West, between Islington Avenue and the Humber River, designated as Part 1 on Sketch No. PS-2015-040 attached to the report linked below.

It is proposed that the by-law be enacted at the Council meeting to be held on May 23, 2018 or at a subsequent meeting.

The proposed highway closure is outlined in the report titled "Permanent Closure of a Portion of the North Side of Steeles Avenue West, between Islington Avenue and the Humber River". To view or obtain a copy of the report that outlines the highway closure, visit the City's website at
