The Mayor and Members of Toronto City Council are deeply saddened to learn of the passing of former Mayor June Rowlands on December 21, 2017.

Ms. Rowlands served on Toronto City Council from 1976 until 1988. June Rowlands would go on to become the City Budget Chief, member of the Executive Committee and the first female chair of both the Toronto Transit Commission and the Metropolitan Toronto Police Commission. In 1991 June Rowlands was elected as the City of Toronto's 60th Mayor, becoming the first female to serve as Mayor of the former City of Toronto.

June Rowlands will be remembered for her dedication to the environment, health, safety, crime and prevention of drug abuse. June Rowlands advocated for women's issues and served as a strong voice for the Davisville community many years after the end of her term in 1994.

In 2004, the City of Toronto recognized June Rowland's dedication and tremendous contributions to public service by renaming a park in the Davisville Community in her honour.

June Rowlands will be greatly missed by her family and all those whose lives she touched.
