Katharine was a leader in Toronto's art community. As a gallerist she was a mentor to hundreds of young and emerging artists. Katharine fostered, promoted and celebrated Toronto's art scene. With galleries in Toronto and New York, Katharine gave a platform to launch the careers of numerous Canadian artists.

Katharine was Instrumental in shaping the queen west art scene in turn reviving the neighbourhood that is now recognized as one of the most dynamic neighbourhoods in Canada. Running multiple businesses along the street and later along Dupont, she was known to everyone in the area. She was a fixture in the community and always greeted you with a smile.
