To Whom This May Concern,

On behalf of the Toronto Downtown Jazz Society (TDJ), presenters of the TD Toronto Jazz Festival, I am formally requesting declaration of the 33rd annual Toronto Jazz Festival, as a "special event of municipal significance".

This declaration will allow application to the Alcohol and Gaming Commission for a Special Occasion Permits to serve alcohol at three (3) festival locations between Friday June 21 through Sunday June 30, 2019.


- 1) QUEENS PARK, between Bloor Street West and the north driveway of Victoria College. Barricaded area on the street.  
 Friday June 21 through Sunday June 23 (opening weekend)  
 Serving hours 4pm-11 pm June 21 and 12Noon-11 pm June 22 & 23
- 2) CUMBERLAND ST, between Bellair Street & Old York Lane  
 Barricaded area on the street  
 Friday June 21 - Sunday June 30  
 Serving hours 12Noon - 10:00pm
- 3) VILLAGE OF YORKVILLE PARK, 115 Cumberland Street  
 Barricaded area within the park  
 Friday June 21 - Sunday June 30  
 Serving hours Daily 12Noon - 10pm

Too primary purpose of TDJ is to present a world-class jazz festival to entertain local residents and visitors through performance, education and outreach and to make the music accessible to everyone by offering a wide variety of quality activities and musical styles. Since 1987 TDJ has presented over 3,400 free concerts, presented over 35,000 artists (85% of whom were Canadian), welcomed 12 million attendees and contributed more than \$600 million in economic benefits to the City of Toronto. The Festival draws over 500,000 people annually to performances at multiple indoor and outdoor Toronto venues.

The 2018 Festival generated \$41.1 M in economic benefit and was ranked the #1 Music Event in Toronto by BizBash for the 2<sup>nd</sup> year in a row.
