DECISION HISTORY

These appointments are subject to approval by the Ontario Minister of Health. Physicians require Associate Medical Officer of Health designation in order to have medico-legal signing authority under the Health Protection and Promotion Act

COMMENTS

Toronto Public Health has a need for a physician to fill the position of Deputy Medical Officer of Health. This physician will be appointed as an Associate Medical Officer of Health as prescribed by the Health Protection and Promotion Act R.S.O. 1990 and support the Medical Officer of Health in fulfilling her responsibilities under the Act.
