Please see attached joint submission to be shared as public record for IE18.1 on Re-Imagine Yonge from the *Bayview Cummer Neighbourhood Association (BCNA)*; and the *Silverview Community Association (SCA)*

Please note that we are not supportive of the proposed lane reductions on Yonge Street which would create a dangerous bottleneck for our residents.

In surveying residents across Ward 18, 17 and 15 with the support of other neighborhood associations we have learned:

- 71% were not aware of the proposed lane reductions on Yonge Street
- 82.5% do not support lane reductions for private vehicles on Yonge Street
- 82% felt the time delays from the lane reductions could limit employment or extra curricular activities for residents and children post pandemic.
