The Mayor and Members of Toronto City Council are deeply saddened to learn of the passing of Andrzej Jordan-Rozwadowski (Andre Jordan) on December 21, 2020.

Andre Jordan was born in Poland and spent his teenage years in England. His career path was soon realized at the age of 16, when he visited the Eguzon Hydroelectric Dam in France and was so impressed by it that he decided to become an engineer.

Andre Jordan settled down in Canada with his wife, Basia and they had three children: a daughter Teresa, and two sons, Pawel and Michal.

Andre Jordan was a civil engineer who was known for approaching any task very sensibly and with great integrity and compassion. One of his biggest projects in Canada was as a Project Manager on the building of the CN Tower. His impressive work was recognized by Engineering News Record which named him "a newsmaker" and someone who made his mark in the industry in 1974.

Andre Jordan went on to help build Terminal 3 at Toronto Pearson International Airport and helped build several other international airports. He also led the construction of irrigation projects in Peru and Sri Lanka which helped improve the lives of many citizens.

Although, Mr. Jordan had a very successful career, eventually becoming senior vice-president at Aecon, he was also known for being a devoted husband, father, grandfather and uncle who always placed family before his career.
