Where are we at?

- Results-based management framework in development
- Four project selection elements now confirmed by LC3 Centres
- Final framework will go to:
 - Local centres for review in Aug 2021
 - GMF-LC3 Cttee for recommendation in Sept 2021
 - GMF Council for final approval in Nov 2021
- Application of new metrics starting in **2022**





What is Being Proposed?

- Updating of TAF's existing performance metrics
- Application of metrics to:
 - Performance tracking
 - Annual reporting
 - Grant, internal project and impact investment selection
- Testing and refinement of new shared metrics over 24 months in response LC3 centres' user experience

- Potential GHG reductions at scale (& related emission metrics eg. \$/tCO2e)
- Capital mobilization & follow-on investment for LC solutions
- Economic & social benefits resulting from LC solutions
- Applicable initiatives / lessons learned transferred across the LC3 network

Implications of New Metrics

- Integrated review of carbon, co-benefits and equity adds complexity and gives us new ways to frame our work
- Alignment of metrics gives LC3 centres more comparable data to learn from
- We're not exactly sure what measurements will work to give us useful information
- We will adjust the measurement framework over time
