No. 291-67. A BY-LAW

To stop up and close a portion of Market Street between Front Street East and the lane first south of King Street East as a public highway.

[Passed June 21, 1967.]

Whereas by Report No. 8 of the Committee on Public Works adopted in Council on April 26, 1967, it is recommended that the portion of Market Street between Front Street East and the lane first south of King Street East, hereinafter more particularly described, be stopped up and closed as a public highway;

Therefore the Council of the Corporation of the City of Toronto enacts as follows:

1. That the portion of Market Street between Front Street East and the lane first south of King Street East described by A. Douglas Ford, Esquire, O.L.S., City Surveyor, as follows, namely:

All and singular that certain parcel or tract of land and premises situate, lying and being in the City of Toronto, in the County of York and Province of Ontario, being composed of part of the public highway known as Market Street, being part of the Market Block according to the Town of York Plan and shown as West Market Place on a plan filed in the Registry Office for the Registry Division of Toronto as 5A, the said part of Market Street being bounded on the south by a straight line drawn from the intersection of the east limit of Market Street with the northerly limit of Front Street East, to a point in the westerly limit of Market Street distant 30.00 feet measured northerly thereon from the said northerly limit of Front Street East and bounded on the north by a line drawn parallel to and at the perpendicular distance of 116.00 feet southerly from the southerly limit of King Street East.

is hereby stopped up and closed as a public highway.







PLAN OF


PART OF MARKET STREET NORTH OF FRONT STREET EAST
