To adopt a design for the City of Toronto Flag.


[Passed December 9, 1974.]

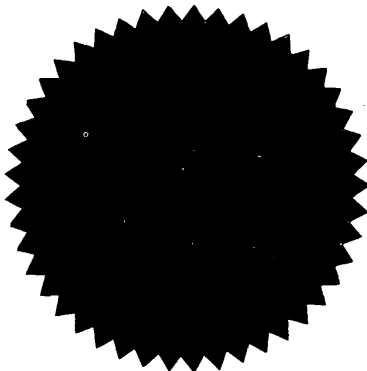
