

No. 349-88. A BY-LAW

To amend By-law No. 34-74, being "A By-law To provide for the use, regulation, protection and government of Nathan Phillips Square.", to prohibit the use of skateboards thereon and to increase the maximum penalty thereunder to \$2,000.00.

(Passed May 2, 1988.)

Whereas by Clause 39 of City Services Committee Report No. 11 adopted by Council at its meeting held on May 2, 1988, it is recommended that certain amendments be made to By-law No. 34-74;

Therefore the Council of The Corporation of the City of Toronto enacts as follows:


1. By-law No. 34-74, being "A By-law To provide for the use, regulation, protection and government of Nathan Phillips Square.", is amended by:

(1) inserting the following subsection in section 2 as subsection 2(j):

"(j) ride or stand on a skateboard"

(2) deleting section 8 and substituting the following therefor:

"(8) Every person who contravenes any of the provisions of this By-law, shall upon conviction thereof, forfeit and pay a penalty not exceeding (exclusive of costs), the sum of \$2,000.00 for each offence."
