



**Baltimore Oriole (*Icterus galbula*)**

The Baltimore Oriole is a seasonal resident migrating through forested areas to and from its southern destinations. The male's black head, wings and tail and orange underparts and shoulders make it one of our most distinctive migratory birds.



**The Rose-Breasted Grosbeak (*Phoebastria rosea*)**

The Rose-Breasted Grosbeak has a strong tick bill for cracking shells of nuts it finds in forest trees.



**The Red-Eyed Vireo (*Vireo olivaceus*)**

The Red-Eyed Vireo can be found high up in the forest trees singing long into the afternoon and checking underneath branches and leaves for insects to eat.
