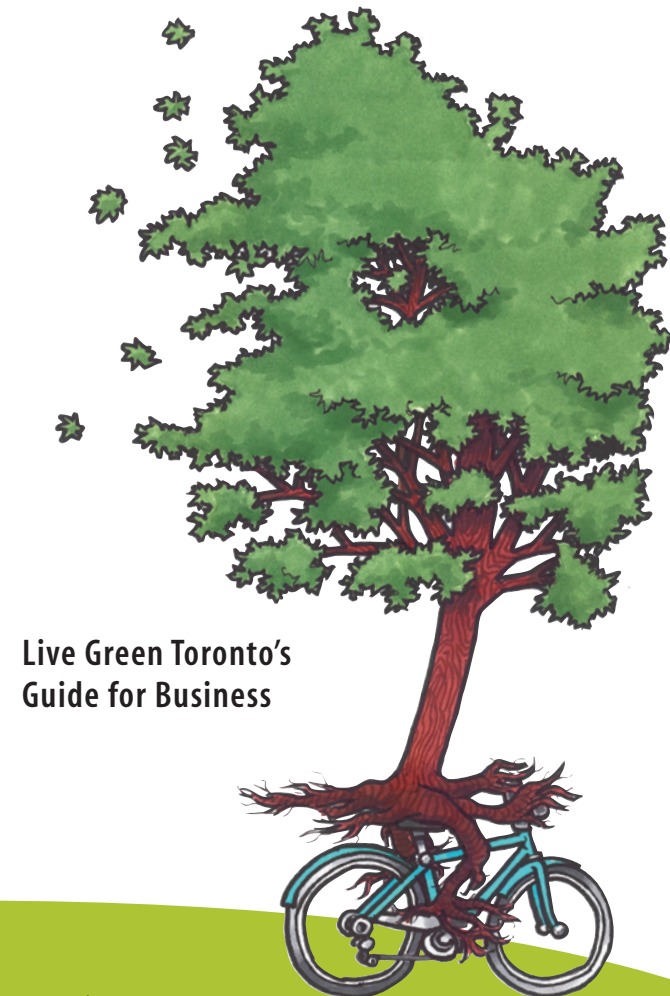

Save money and green your business

Grants, incentives, rebates and programs from the City of Toronto, Toronto Hydro and Enbridge Gas Distribution.

Reduce the energy you use for central air conditioning during peak demand periods, and receive an incentive when you sign up for Toronto Hydro's commercial **peaksaver**® program.

Enjoy extensive promotion and attract new customers when you join the City's FREE Live Green Toronto Membership Card Program.

Increase productivity and employee morale with customized carpooling, transit, walking, cycling and telework programs from the City's Smart Commute Toronto team.

Keep your cool and save energy by keeping your doors closed.

Get incentives for retrofits which improve the energy efficiency of your building from Toronto Hydro's Retrofit Program.

Own a restaurant? Get a free, high-velocity pre-rinse spray valve through the City/Enbridge Spray 'n' Save Program.

Get a one-time incentive (up to 30 cents/litre of water saved/average day) with the City's Capacity Buy Back Program when you make permanent process and/or equipment changes that reduce your water use.

Receive \$50 per square metre when you install a green roof, or \$5 per square metre when you install a cool/white roof through the City's Eco-Roof Incentive Program. (Ends December, 2011.)

Get up to \$1,000 in FREE energy efficiency upgrades through Toronto Hydro's Small Business Lighting program.

Get advice, technical support and potential financial incentives for your new construction project. (City of Toronto Better Buildings Partnership)

Help reduce toxic chemicals. Your business association or community group may be eligible for up to \$25,000 from the City's ChemTRAC Toxics Reduction Grants Program.

Get a FREE tree planted on the City-owned allowance next to your private property.

With Toronto Hydro's Audit Funding program, businesses can take advantage of incentives to complete energy audits assessing the potential for energy savings.

If you're eligible for garbage collection with the City's Yellow Bag Program, you can receive free recycling and organic collection, and send less waste to landfill.
