### **PROPOSAL**

The City of Toronto is proposing an amendment to the Official Plan to introduce area-specific policies for properties on Bloor Street West, between Avenue Road and Bathurst Street. The draft amendment is intended to implement a vision for the area as determined through the Bloor Corridor Visioning Study process, in consultation with the local community and area representatives. The City is also proposing draft Urban Design Guidelines to provide further direction for potential future development in the area.

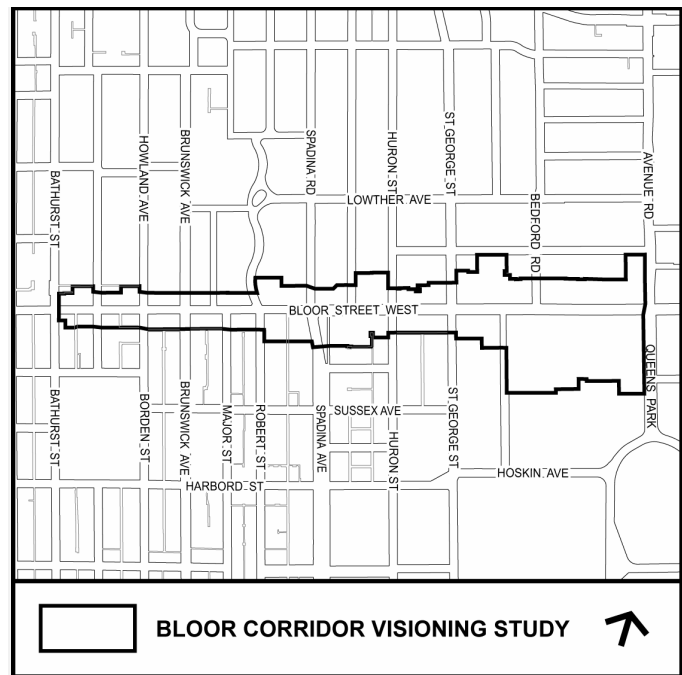
## FURTHER INFORMATION

**If you wish to be notified** of the adoption or refusal of the proposed Official Plan Amendment, you must make a written request to the City Clerk, attention: Rosalind Dyers, Administrator, Toronto And East York Community Council, at the address set out in this notice or by Fax: (416) 397-0111.

**Official Plan Amendment Appeal:** If a person or public body does not make oral submissions at a public meeting or make written submissions to the City Clerk, attention: Rosalind Dyers, Administrator, Toronto and East York Community Council, at the address set out in this notice or by Fax: (416) 397-0111 before the proposed Official Plan Amendment is adopted or refused, the person or public body is not entitled to appeal the decision to the Ontario Municipal Board and may not be added as a party to the hearing of an appeal before the Ontario Municipal Board unless, in the opinion of the Board, there are reasonable grounds to do so.

**People writing or making presentations at the public meeting:** The *City of Toronto Act, 2006*, the *Planning Act*, and the City of Toronto Municipal Code authorize the City of Toronto to collect any personal information in your communication or presentation to City Council or its committees.

The City collects this information to enable it to make informed decisions on the relevant issue(s). If you are submitting letters, faxes, e-mails, presentations or other communications to the City, you should be aware that your name and the fact that you communicated with the City will become part of the public record and will appear on the City's website.
