Niagara Community Meeting

The Niagara area, roughly bounded by Bathurst Street, King Street West, Shaw Street and the CN Weston (Georgetown) rail corridor, is experiencing significant incremental change, mostly through the conversion of industrial buildings and lands to residential developments. City Council has directed staff to review the built form and density policies and the transportation requirements of the area.

Purpose of the Meeting

The meeting will provide an opportunity for neighbourhood residents and landowners:

- to learn about existing, approved and proposed redevelopments, both in the Niagara area and around it, and the impacts they may have on transportation and community facilities;
- to learn about existing policies for the Niagara area;
- to express their views on the strengths and weaknesses of the area; and
- to consider the various forms of redevelopment which may be appropriate in different parts of the area.
