Finch-Warden Revitalization Study Working Group Meetings **Recap of Design Charette**

- Purpose of this meeting was to provide clarification on what was said, and also ensure accuracy in note taking.
- Reviewed table by table comments to ensure accuracy and whether additional information was needed. This included both morning and afternoon sessions.
- Also wanted to work on a community vision statement to accurately reflect communities vision.

Comments (Feedback from the community by table)

- Overall each table had very few changes to make.
- Some minor changes but overall point remained consistent.
- Additional points were discussed and noted. Additions will be posted online.
- Community happy with accurate reporting of suggestions/concerns.
- Community requested January 22, 2009, meeting notes involving application at 2900 Warden Avenue be posted on line.
- Committed to posting this information, which would also include presentation made by Stand up Bridletowne group.

Other Comments

- Draft Community Vision Statement prepared during Charette by Table 4 was discussed.
- Staff suggested that we would like input into how statement should read. Would like other working group members to provide suggested wording. May require reworking/massaging of statement to ensure all important information is present.
- Staff informed working group future meeting dates on March 10 and April 7 will be moved approximately 2 weeks later.
- Staff committed to provide draft of Community Vision document prior to next meeting. This will allow group to review and provide suggestions at subsequent working group meeting.
