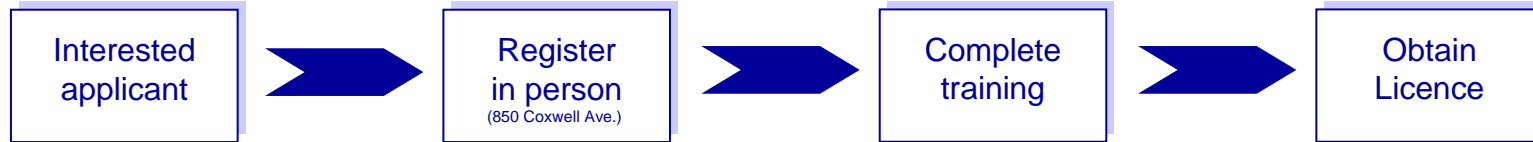

How to become a Taxicab Driver



Is taxicab driving for you?
 Taxicab driving offers:

- flexible work hours
- self-employment
- good income potential
- meeting people
- tax-deductible expenses

To register you will need to:

- pay the course fee of \$590.95
- complete a registration form
- sign a waiver allowing the City to obtain a criminal check and driver's abstract
- present two pieces of ID
- present a class "G" provincial driver's licence
- demonstrate eligibility to work in Canada

You will receive:

- receipt (keep for tax purposes)
- course confirmation for taxi training and CPR course
- pre-study package
- medical certificate

The "Effective Taxicab Driver Training Program":

- is 17 days long
- is held weekdays, from 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.
- takes place at the Municipal Licensing and Standards Training Centre (located at: 1530 Markham Road, 3rd Floor)

To obtain your licence you must:

- have successfully completed all training
- present your First Aid/CPR certificate (part of the course)
- present a medical certificate signed by a qualified physician



Effective Taxicab Driver Training Program

The Effective Taxicab Training Program is a 17-day training program for individuals wishing to acquire a taxicab driver's licence in the City of Toronto. This program is designed to improve the quality and effectiveness of individuals interested in pursuing a career as a professional taxicab driver.

To successfully complete the course, participants must meet attendance requirements, obtain a minimum grade of 70% on every section of the final exam, and achieve a final overall course grade of 80%.
