Next Steps (i)

- ❑ **Two Obvious Issues**
 - ❑ Vehicle emissions esp. along major highways (DVP)
 - ❑ Local industrial sources (e.g. CanRoof)
- ❑ **Two Different Approaches**
 - ❑ Work w TPH/Province/etc persuade Feds re: CAFÉ
 - ❑ Partner w MOE re: local industrial issues
 - ❑ TEO models + MOE monitors + MOE regulations

Next Steps (ii)

❑ **Other City Neighbourhoods**

- ❑ Ward 5 & 6 next, plus others (cheaper & quicker)
- ❑ Build support re: approaches city-wide

❑ **SRLB**

- ❑ ChemTRAC data will be modelled when available
- ❑ Communicate “new findings” to SRLB
- ❑ Leave email contacts for updates

What You Can Do (i)

- ❑ Save Energy - Save Money - Save the Air
 - ❑ **Reduce your Local Natural Gas Consumption**
 - ❑ Clean furnace filters, lower thermostat settings
 - ❑ Upgrade insulation in your home
 - ❑ Use less hot water
 - ❑ **Reduce your Local Driving and Gas Consumption**
 - ❑ Leave the car at home – bike, walk, take transit
 - ❑ **Persuade Others to Do As You Do!**
