Virginia Creeper	<i>Parthenocissis vitacea</i>	Moist	sand-silt-loam	sun to partial shade	10 m	bright red fall colour
Black Currant	<i>Ribes americanum</i>	Moist-Wet	sand-silt-clay	partial shade to shade	1 m	black berries
Prickly Gooseberry	<i>Ribes cynosbati</i>	Dry-Moist	sand-silt-clay	partial shade to shade	1 m	reddish-purple to black berries
Canada Gooseberry	<i>Ribes hirtellum</i>	Dry-Moist	sand-silt-clay	partial shade to shade	1 m	bluish-black berries
Common Blackberry	<i>Rubus allegheniensis</i>	Dry-Moist	sand-silt-loam	sun to partial shade	2 m	thimble-shaped black berries
Northern Dewberry	<i>Rubus flagellaris</i>	Dry	Sand	full sun	4 m	red edible fruit
Wild Red Raspberry	<i>Rubus idaeus</i>	Dry-Moist-Wet	sand-silt-clay	sun to partial shade	2 m	red edible fruit
Black Raspberry	<i>Rubus occidentalis</i>	Dry-Moist	sand-silt-clay	full sun	2 m	black edible fruit
Bristly Greenbrier	<i>Smilax hispida</i>	Moist	sand-silt-clay	sun to shade	6 m	blue/black berries
