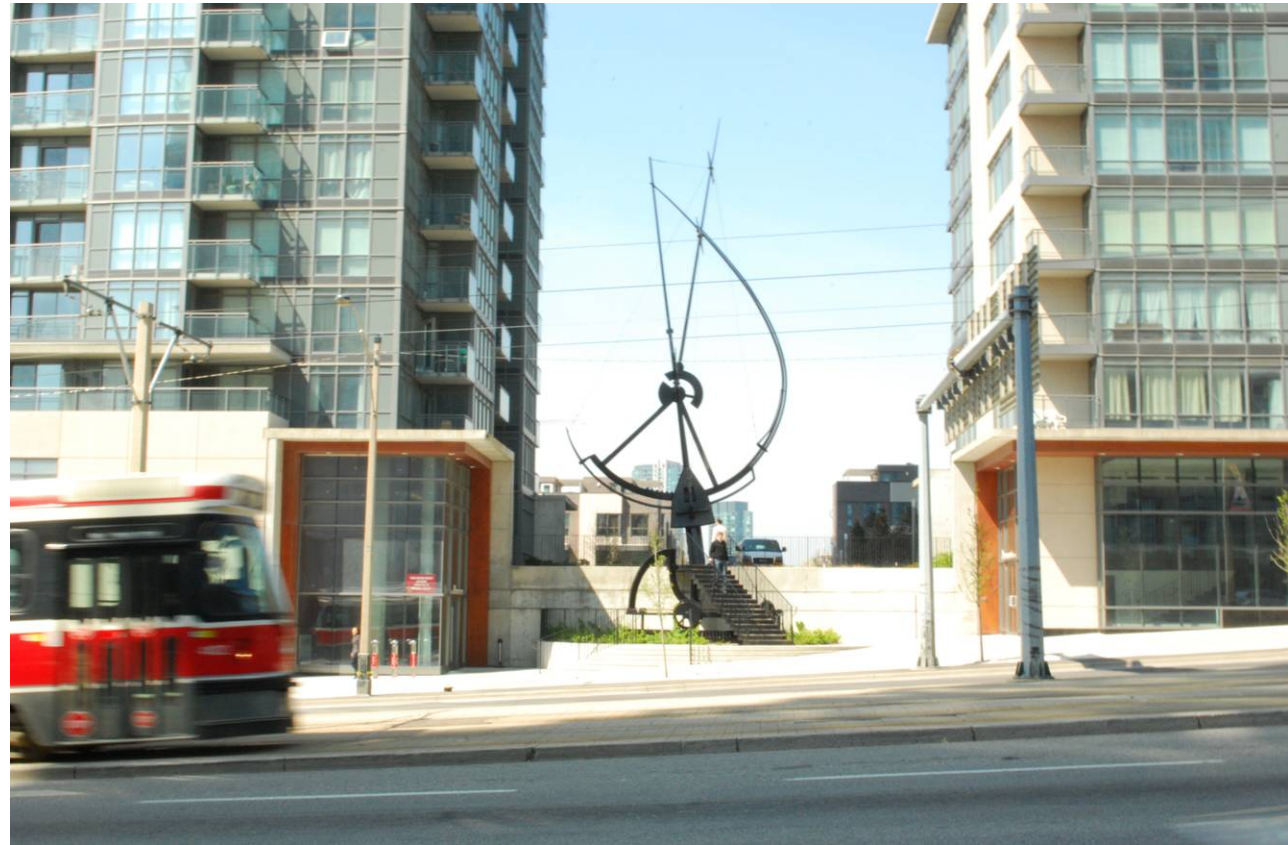

Public art is a cohesive element throughout the community of CityPlace. The pedestrian levels along Fort York Boulevard and Spadina Avenue were studied in detail to incorporate a rich and varied palette of materials on the built-form and to integrate architecture with interior design, landscaping and public art.

The Integrated Art at West One and Gallery continues the exploration of site history as the conceptual basis for public art in CityPlace; the old shoreline, harbour and general proximity to the lake are evoked through the program of artworks recalling marine devices . Each element serves to create a unifying theme that helps mark the transition between the private and public realms, best exemplified by the *Rosa Nautica* and its feature staircase set between the two main lobbies of West One and Gallery on the west side of Spadina Avenue.
