In the vibrant Scarborough City Centre, five planned condominiums will frame Albert Campbell Square and speak to the public transportation and pedestrian realms of this vibrant Toronto location. The modern glass and pre-cast towers Equinox I and Equinox II combine to form a sleek landmark that is well integrated in the Scarborough City Centre, which encompass a vibrant traffic node for the City of Toronto. Residents live steps from the Town Centre and SRT, which offer a quick connection to the Kennedy subway station. The towers complement Albert Campbell Square with a podium containing grade-related retail that frames the pedestrian realm of the area. The project creates a sense of place and security, and provides an “eyes on the square” atmosphere that encourage pedestrian activity use. The architectural massing and detailing of the towers make a prominent contribution to the city’s skyline.
