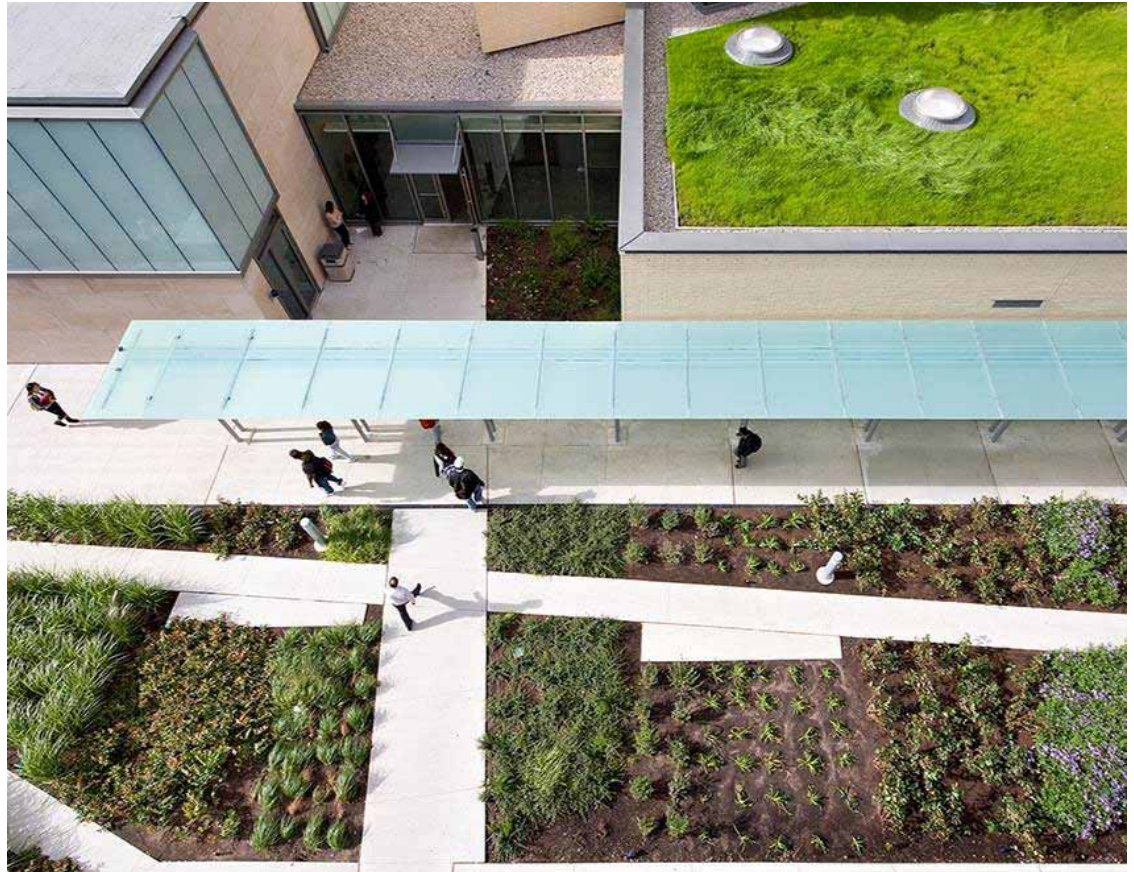

This new four storey buff brick and limestone building responds to both the demands of a complex program and to the responsibility for making a contribution to the public space of the campus.

The new building acts as the main entry point to the campus. It builds on the strengths of the original internationally recognized John Andrews ravine edged campus of the 1960s, while mitigating the weaknesses of the much less distinguished 1970s buildings on the table land. The new building facilitates the extension of existing interior and exterior pedestrian routes and the definition of a series of landscaped courts and walkways from previously residual and undefined outdoor space. This project is as much about repairing a campus precinct as about the design of a particular building.
