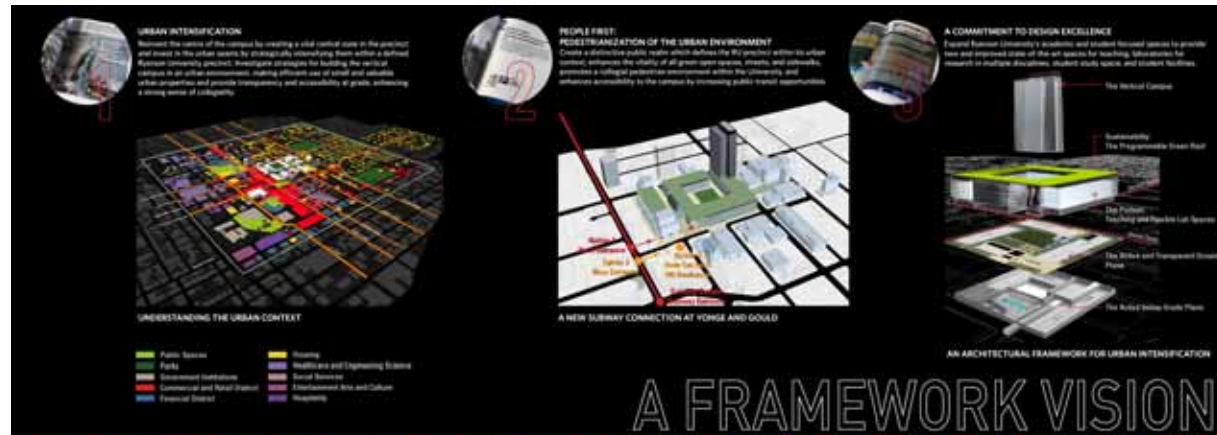

Occupying approximately 21 acres in the heart of downtown Toronto, Ryerson University - unlike gated campuses of traditional urban universities – is a loosely organized campus subsumed by its surrounding urban context. The 2008 Master Plan balances strategies to address functional space requirements with aspirations to activate RU as a 'city builder'. Organized around three broad goals, each with a set of implementation principles, the master plan creates a framework against which to make decisions about campus growth to benefit the University and the City for decades to come.

The framework vision focuses on strengthening the original campus core – Kerr Hall and its Quad – while also investing in development along the vehicular and pedestrian traffic corridors that intersect the campus. It identifies a few short term projects to achieve visible and positive change quickly with long term strategies to ensure the sustainable evolution of the RU campus for the education and training of the next generation of contributors to the economic engines of Toronto, Ontario and Canada.
