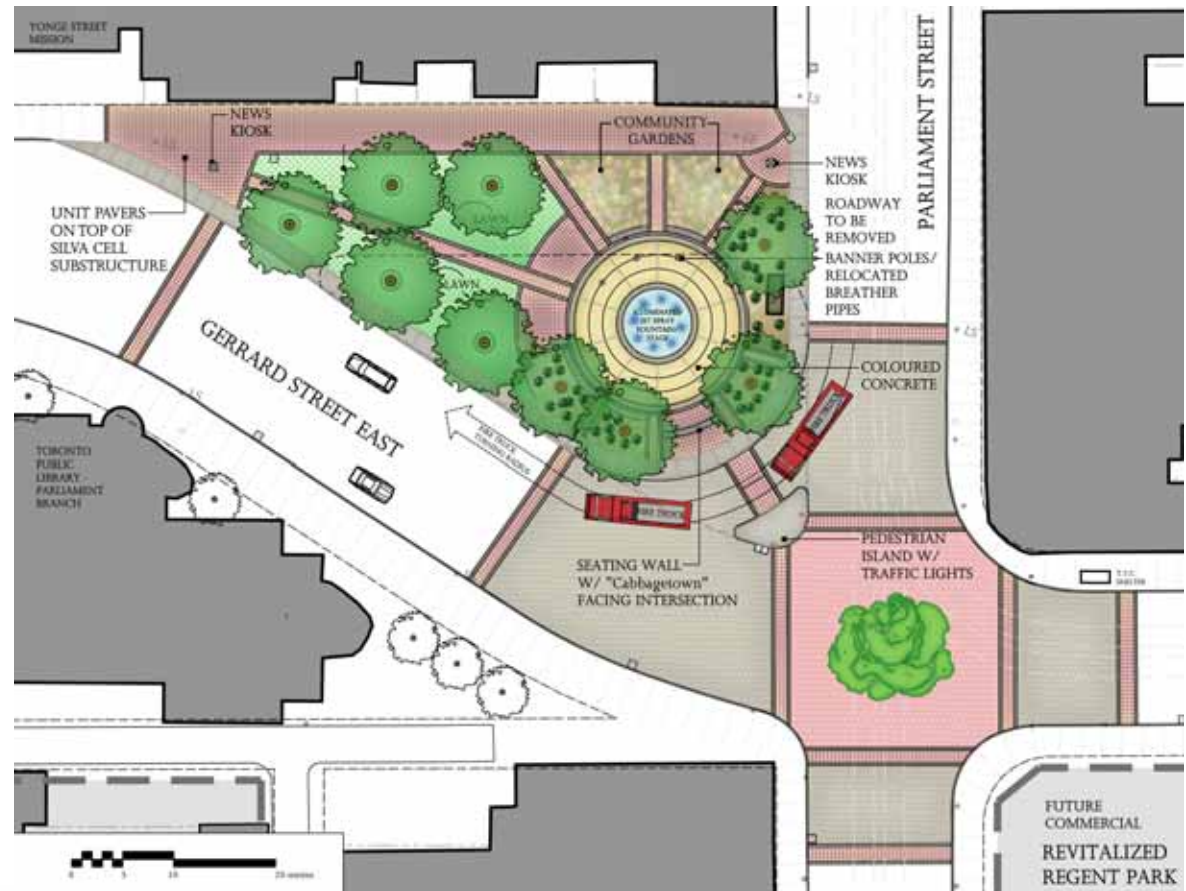

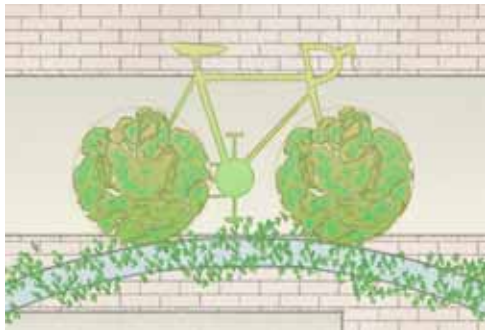

Building on the community spirit and historic character of this unique neighbourhood, the Old Cabbagetown BIA Streetscape Revitalization Plan provides guidance and direction to the BIA on future physical improvements to the public right-of-way. The creation of consistent and unified streetscape themes within a coherent framework will guide future capital upgrades so they are carried out in a way that strengthens the identity and visual coherence of the area. This community-driven study was initiated by the citizen's group, Cabbagetown 2.0 Public Space Committee. Key objectives of this study are: pedestrian safety and comfort, increased tree canopy and vegetation cover, additional bicycle parking, flexibility and adaptability of use of space, and the preparation of streetscape design details which are unique to the area. In this planning study, green infrastructure is considered equal in importance to that of traditional infrastructure.
