In the heart of Toronto's thriving King West Village, master-planned Liberty Village is a tapestry of century-old buildings and vintage landmarks with a thread of soaring contemporary condominiums woven into the area's urban fabric. With a unique urban vision for a condominium neighbourhood within Liberty Village, Battery Park, Zip and Vibe create an iconic landmark. Integrated into the area in phases, the 23- and 24-storey buildings are among the first tall buildings in the vicinity. Extensive landscaping along the separation between the buildings offers a distinctive visual impact for each, and the shared central drop-off facilities and parkette to the south add to the harmonious nature of the community. Each condominium features a podium and is stepped back to honour the pedestrian scale. The buildings are linked by two glass-enclosed pedestrian bridges, which will house public art and will provide convenience for residents accessing the amenities among the towers.
