As described in the presentation, the change in land use allowed on the site being considered by the TTC for the LRV Maintenance and Storage Facility will be considered by the Public Works & Infrastructure (PW&I) Committee. If it is endorsed by PW&I, it will be considered by City Council.

Deputations are limited to five (5) minutes, and deputants must register in order to be placed on the committee Agenda.
