I have enclosed the draft Agenda. Please note that this will be a special "working" meeting of the NLC, as decided at the last meeting on February 25. This means that participants will be working in small groups on two issues. At the end of each working session, each group will report back to the larger group on their discussions, questions and conclusions.

Given the interest shown at the last meeting and to help give context to the working groups, Toronto Water will be reporting to the NLC on future land use requirements at the ABTP, and providing details on why land in the vicinity of the proposed Light Rail Vehicle Maintenance and Storage Facility will not be needed for plant operations. Representatives of the Toronto Transit Commission will also be available to answer questions.

This meeting will be facilitated by City staff from the Public Consultation Unit. Meeting minutes will be in the form of a report on discussions and conclusions.

The issues being discussed are:

1. ABTP Odour Complaint Procedure, and
2. criteria for evaluating proposed uses or developments on the ABTP site.

The background material for the Odour Complaint Protocol issue was first presented to the NLC at Meeting #94 on September 17, 2009. The same material is included here for your reference. Please come prepared to discuss and provide comment on the Odour Complaint Procedure at the ABTP.

Part of the NLC's mandate is to "develop criteria for evaluating proposed uses or developments on the MTP [ABTP] Site" (Section 1.1.2 of the NLC Terms of Reference). This will be the focus of the second working session on April 19.
