The City's Public Works & Infrastructure Committee (PWIC) considered a change in land use to allow for the construction of a Toronto Transit Commission (TTC) Light Rail Vehicle Maintenance and Storage Facility (LRV M&SF) at their meeting on May 18, 2010.
