- Q1. Clarify item 3 under Respondent Capability, Section 4.1 Proposed RFQL Screening Criteria (For Respondent's Comment), page 20 "Respondent will have to provide proof that it is incorporated in Ontario." Does this preclude potential respondents from other countries?
- A1. Potential suppliers of technologies may be based in any country. However, since the City of Toronto is looking for a local solution, the City will expect potential suppliers to have a local agent or partner organisation. An agent may be incorporated in Ontario for the purpose of this project. This is not required to respond to this REOI, but will be required at the RFQL and RFP stages.
- Q2. Given that the City is not interested in incineration, would it be worth submitting an expression of interest for a thermal technology such as gasification or vitrification?
- A2. Through this REOI the City intends to evaluate new and emerging technologies, and as noted on page 8 of the REOI document, technologies of interest to the City "...may incorporate a broad range of *physical, biological, chemical and/or advanced thermal processes*." These may include thermal technologies applied to the treatment of municipal solid waste such as, but not limited to, pyrolysis, gasification and vitrification, and would encourage suppliers of such technologies to respond to this REOI. Since the City is not interested in incineration technologies for management of its residual municipal waste at this time, for thermal processes, the City requests respondents to provide "...a description of how the process is different from incineration" (Section 3.0, item 1, page 13 of the REOI document).

Please attach this addendum to your Expression of Interest document and be governed accordingly.

All other terms and conditions remain the same.
