

Draft Resolutions

The following draft resolutions are for discussion purposes at the June 25th meeting of the New and Emerging Technologies, Policies and Practices Advisory Group.

The Advisory Group has taken no position on these draft resolutions.

1. There be an individual EA for the City's planning and decision-making on the utilization of new and emerging technologies, policies and practices for processing of Toronto's residual solid waste (up to 40% of the total waste stream) as set out under the requirements of the Ontario Environmental Assessment Act.
2. a). The EA should address all phases of planning and decision-making, including (1) the choice of technology(ies) (i.e. "alternatives to") and (2) the siting of facilities (i.e. "alternative methods"). The City should begin the development of Terms of Reference for the EA as required by the EA Act as soon as possible.

OR

- b). The EA should address the planning and decision-making only for the siting of facilities (i.e. "alternative methods"). The City should begin the development of Terms of Reference for the EA as required by the EA Act as soon as a preferred technology has been chosen.

OR

- c). The EA should address only a limited set of potential sites. The City should begin the development of Terms of Reference for the EA as required by the EA Act as soon as a short-list of preferred sites has been identified.
