Partial Intersection Closure Queen and Glen Manor Intersection

Scheduled Start Date : Tuesday, April 19 at 10:00 a.m.
Scheduled Completion Date: Friday, April 22 at 10:00am
(timelines are contingent upon weather conditions and unforeseen events)

The intersection of Queen St. East and Glen Manor Drive will be partially closed to vehicular traffic starting at 10:00 a.m. on Tuesday April 19 until 10:00am on Friday April 22 to permit streetcar track reconstruction.

During the Glen Manor intersection work, westbound traffic on Queen Street will be directed north at Beech Avenue. Westbound traffic will not be allowed to proceed across Beech.

Traffic Restrictions during Intersection Construction

North and southbound traffic will NOT be allowed through the Glen Manor intersection. Westbound through traffic will also NOT be permitted. One lane of eastbound traffic will be maintained at all times through the intersection. Eastbound traffic on Queen Street may also turn southbound onto Glen Manor.

Work Hours

Streetcar track intersection construction is a 24-hour operation. All heavy construction work will take place between the hours of 7a.m. and 11p.m., Monday to Friday, with weekend work as required. The overnight operation involves TTC rail installation work consisting of delivery of rail, rail installation, and some rail welding. This work is required to support the daytime operation. Efforts will be made to minimize the noise as much as possible for local residents.

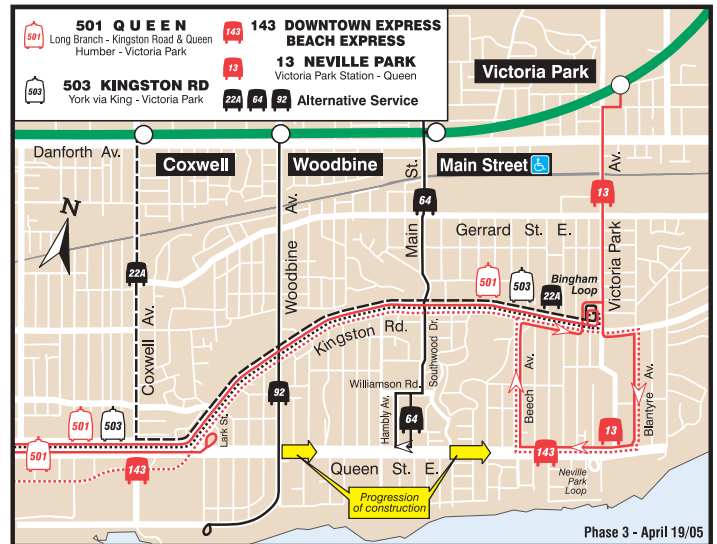

Transit Service Changes

Effective April 19, 2005

Westbound lane closures on Queen Street at Waverly Road and at Beech Avenue.

- Queen streetcars continue to turn back at Kingston Road, and some streetcars run to Bingham loop via Kingston Road.
- 64 Main buses resume regular routing.
- Northbound buses on 143 Downtown-Beach Express and 13 Neville Park routes operate on Beech Avenue, Kingston Road to the Victoria Park Station.
- Southbound buses on 143 Downtown-Beach Express and 13 Neville Park routes operate from Victoria Park Station, on Blantyre Avenue to Queen Street.
