

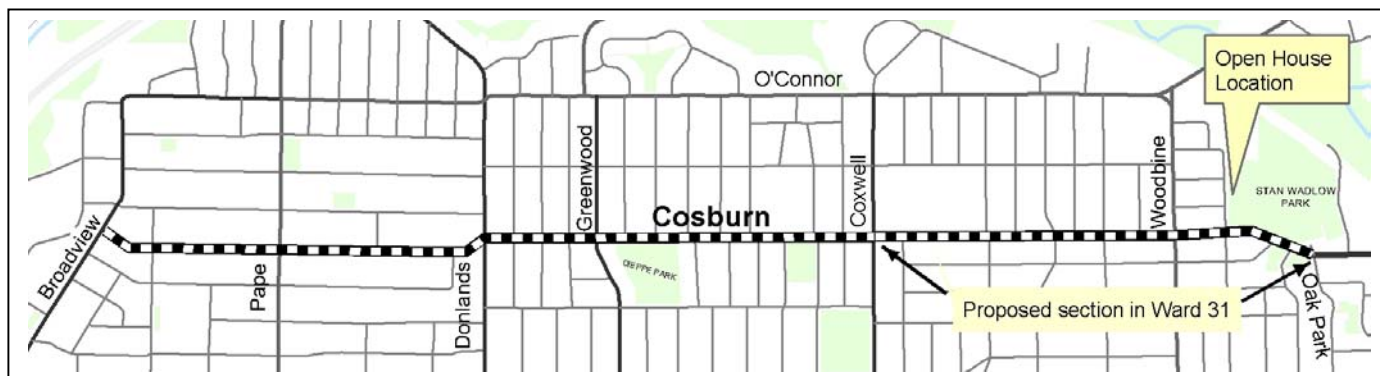
## Public Consultation - Open House Event Proposed Bicycle Lanes on Cosburn Avenue

**Tuesday, July 27, 2004**

Toronto Transportation Services Division and Councillor Janet Davis, Ward 31, Beaches-East York, invite you to a second Open House event on the proposal to install bicycle lanes on Cosburn Avenue from Broadview Avenue to Oak Park Avenue (see back page for proposed design).

This consultation will focus on the section of Cosburn Avenue from Coxwell Avenue to Oak Park Avenue within Ward 31. Transportation staff will be on hand to provide more detailed information about the proposed bicycle lanes, impacts on traffic, and the reconfiguration of parking along the street.

Following the Open House, all comments received will be included in a staff report to Toronto and East York Community Council at its meeting on September 14, 2004. If adopted by Community Council and City Council, the bicycle lanes would be installed in October 2004.

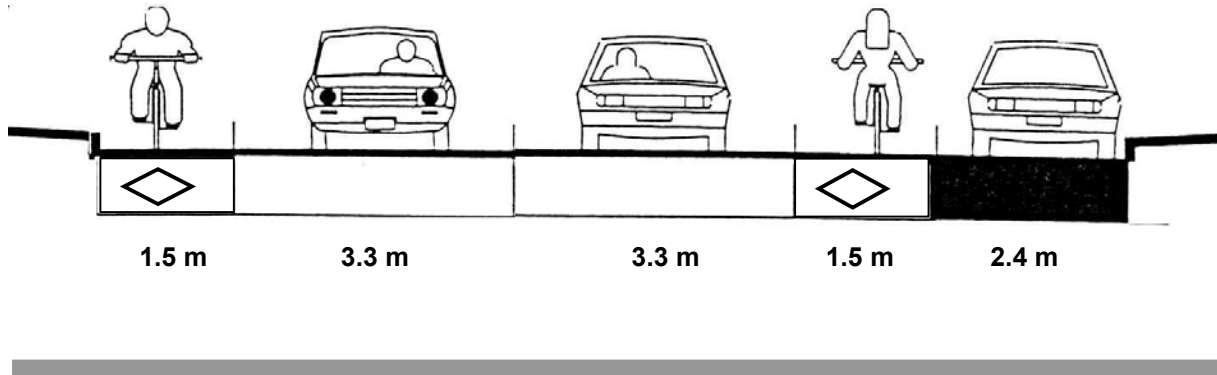


## Proposed Design for Cosburn Avenue Bicycle Lanes

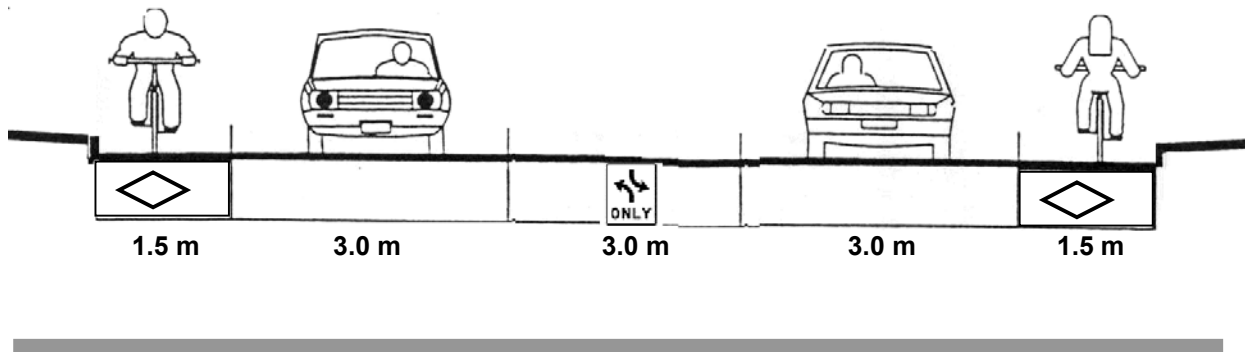
The introduction of bicycle lanes along Cosburn Avenue will require the redesign of the current roadway. The road would be re-stripped to provide one bicycle lane and one traffic lane in each direction, with designated left turn lanes provided at signalised intersections and parking on only one side of the street.
