

Leaside Bridge Rehabilitation

Leaside Bridge between Millwood Road,
Donlands and Pape Avenue over the Don Valley

Weekend Demolition Work

Expected Start Date: May 13, 2006
Expected Completion Date: May 14, 2006

As part of the structural repairs and rehabilitation of the Leaside Bridge, the deteriorated concrete deck, sidewalks and parapet walls are required to be removed. For the safety of the public and of the Don Valley Parkway operations, it is necessary that the overhead demolition of the portion of concrete over the Parkway be carried out without vehicular traffic below. In order to complete the work on the Leaside Bridge this year, this work is now scheduled for the May 13 weekend.

Due to the amount of demolition required, the work will begin during the early hours of May 13th & 14th, taking full advantage of the daylight, of the weekend Parkway closure noted above. An exemption to the City Noise By-Law has been granted for this work as identified in previous public notices for this project. There will be other occasional weekend or night time work on this project in order to maintain completion for this year, but will not involve the noise of concrete demolition.

This rehabilitation work is extremely necessary and when completed should avoid any future major work for a significant period of time.
