## **Royal York Road Major Road Reconstruction Norseman Street to Mimico Creek**

(North of Delroy Drive, East Side of Royal York Road)

The City is holding a Public Information Open House to allow area residents to view the design drawings for the Royal York Road Reconstruction – Phase 8 from Norseman Street to the Mimico Creek Bridge. Project staff will be present to address any questions or concerns you may have.

#### **Design Details**

As part of the 2006 Capital Works program, the Etobicoke York District of Technical Services for The City of Toronto has scheduled the reconstruction of **Royal York Road from Norseman Street to the Mimico Creek Bridge**. Royal York Road has deteriorated to the point that roadway reconstruction is necessary. As part of this work, the City will be replacing the existing watermain and portions of the sanitary and storm sewer systems. Water services and sanitary services will be upgraded from the new street pipes to your front property line. Royal York Road will be reconstructed with curb and gutter and include one vehicle lane and one bicycle lane in each direction. A new storm sewer system in the area will consolidate various existing outlet pipes into one outfall into Mimico Creek. An exfiltration catchbasin and subdrain system will be constructed where appropriate.

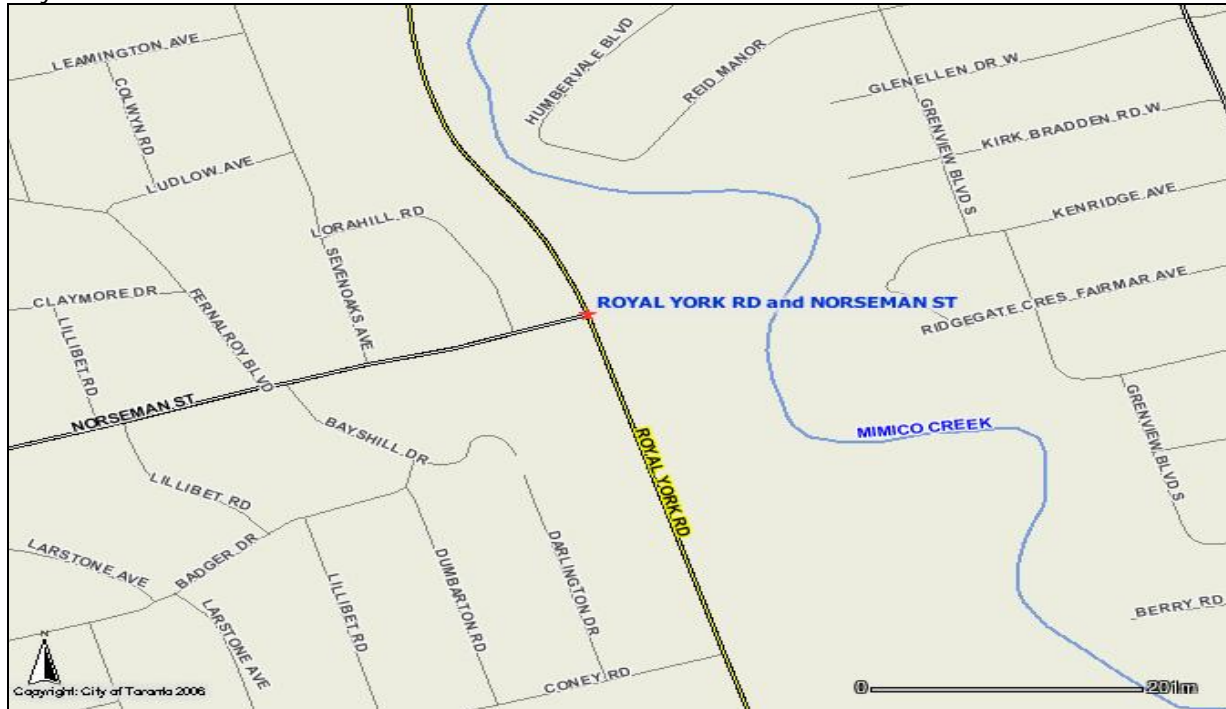
Phase 8 construction will begin in the first week of September, 2007 and will continue until late November 2007. The bulk of the construction is anticipated to take approximately 3 months to complete.

#### **Pedestrian Access and Traffic Details**

In order to complete the road construction work in a safe manner, it will be necessary to reduce traffic lanes. Access to your driveway will be interrupted from time to time during construction. The contractor is obligated to notify you of any temporary driveway closures. The City will make arrangements for parking on side streets at times when driveway access has been interrupted. Before construction starts, a further notice will be issued detailing which streets are available for parking. During construction the west sidewalk will remain open as well as a part of the east sidewalk from the pedestrian bridge crossing Mimico Creek southwards to Norseman Street.
