# Scarlett Road / CP Rail Bridge

## MUNICIPAL CLASS ENVIRONMENTAL ASSESSMENT – NOTICE OF COMPLETION OF ENVIRONMENTAL STUDY REPORT

### The Study

The City of Toronto has completed a Municipal Class Environmental Assessment (EA) Study to address existing traffic safety and operational concerns and long term mobility needs in the Scarlett Road/St. Clair Avenue/Dundas Street area. The study was undertaken in accordance with the requirements for Schedule 'C' projects under the Municipal Class Environmental Assessment. The Environmental Study Report (ESR), which documents the evaluation and decision making process, was recently approved by City of Toronto Council and is now available for review.

### The Recommendation

The recommended design, as documented in the ESR, includes the following:

- A new two-span, through-plate girder railway bridge, with minimum vertical clearance of 5.0 m above Scarlett Road;
- Two northbound and two southbound lanes on Scarlett Road under the bridge, as well as a bicycle lane and sidewalk on each side;
- Horizontal and vertical clearances designed to accommodate potential future streetcar service in exclusive lanes;
- A new traffic control signal for Gooch Avenue at Dundas Street West, through an offset intersection with Scarlett Road; and
- Eastbound dual left-turn lanes on Dundas Street West at Scarlett Road.
