

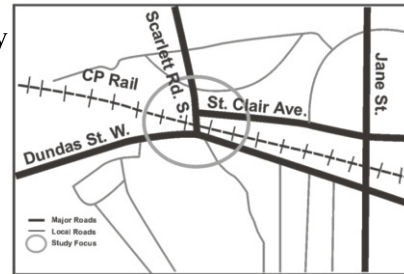
# Scarlett Road/CP Rail Bridge Environmental Assessment Study

## Notice of Public Meeting and Open House

### Background

The City of Toronto's Works and Emergency Services Department is conducting an Environmental Assessment (EA) Study to address existing traffic safety and operational concerns and long term mobility needs in the Scarlett Road/St. Clair Avenue/Dundas Street area.

At our first public meeting in June 2004, we presented information on the safety and operational problems at this location and an evaluation of a range of possible solutions. The conclusion of the evaluation was to replace the existing CP Rail bridge as well as other intersection improvements.



### Your Comments are Welcome

Since the first public meeting, we have been developing and evaluating alternative designs for Scarlett Road and the CP Rail bridge. Now, we are holding a second open house for the EA study to seek community input on the details and evaluation of the alternative designs and on how previous feedback from the June 2004 meeting has been incorporated to date.
