Class Environmental Assessment Study Public Meeting and Open House

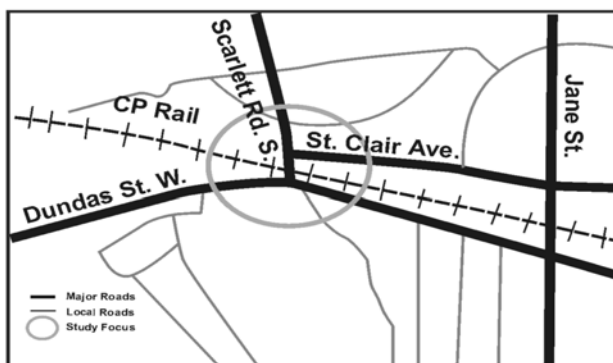
The Opportunity

The City of Toronto is undertaking a Class Environmental Assessment Study to identify a preferred design for improvements to the Canadian Pacific (CP) Galt Subdivision Rail Bridge over Scarlett Road and the intersections of Scarlett Road with Dundas Street West and St. Clair Avenue West. This study will examine improvements to the road and bridge infrastructure and streetscape, in order to enhance safety and assist movement for pedestrians, cyclists, and vehicles in the vicinity of the bridge.

The Study

The study is being undertaken in accordance with the guidelines for a Schedule 'C' Municipal Class Environmental Assessment (EA). The Class EA is an approved process under the Ontario Environmental Assessment Act, and defines the steps the City must follow when planning to implement changes to these roadways and the bridge.

As part of the planning process for this Class EA study, a number of alternative solutions for improvements have been identified. These alternatives and the preliminary assessment and evaluation will be presented at the public meeting.



We would like to hear from you

Public consultation is vital to this study. It is important that your comments or concerns relating to this study be known early so that they may be incorporated in the evaluation of the alternatives. This public meeting will include a presentation concerning the following subjects: 1) the need and justification for this study, 2) the list of alternative solutions identified to date, 3) the evaluation of these alternative solutions and 4) a preliminary preferred solution.
