

## St. Clair Avenue West Transit Improvements Project Notice of Open House

The St. Clair Avenue West Transit Improvements Project is the construction of a dedicated right-of-way for streetcars to improve transit frequency and reliability. The project scope includes urban design enhancements and public art along sections of the avenue.

The City of Toronto and the Toronto Transit Commission will be hosting an Open House to present information about Phase 3 (Vaughan Road to Westmount Avenue) of the St. Clair Avenue West Transit Improvements Project. The Open House will include an overview of the upcoming construction on St. Clair Avenue West from Vaughan Road to Westmount Avenue as well as an update on the Interpretive Plaque Project. Poster boards illustrating the enhanced streetscape design will be on display.

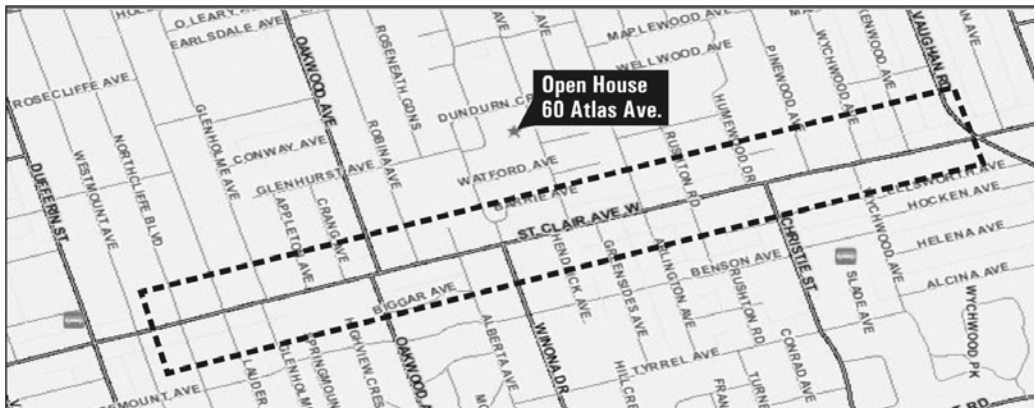
### Phase Three: Construction begins this spring – Vaughan Road to Westmount Avenue

Track and roadway construction work for Vaughan Road to Westmount Avenue (one block east of Dufferin Street) is scheduled to begin in spring 2008. It is anticipated that the majority of the work will be completed by year end. The construction activities include watermain replacement, new hydrants and new valves, track replacement in a raised dedicated right-of-way, streetscape enhancements, road and sidewalk work, installation of new streetcar passenger platforms and transit shelters, and upgraded street lighting.

### Updates:

Current construction of Phase 2 from Westmount Avenue westward to McRoberts Avenue is scheduled to be completed by summer 2008.

Due to strong public support, the City of Toronto and the TTC have arranged to maintain the Wychwood transit stop.



### Interpretive Plaque Project

New streetcar shelters along the St Clair Avenue West 512 route from Yonge Street to Gunns Road have been designed with space for an interpretive community plaque. The plaques express community identity, local history and other unique qualities. The aim of this project is to 'Give Voice' to the people, places and events that have shaped the neighbourhoods of St Clair Avenue West
